Year 8 Visit to Maritime Museum, Liverpool – Thursday 2nd March 2023

I am writing to invite your child to participate in a visit to the Maritime Museum in Liverpool on **Thursday 2nd March**, to complement their studies on African American slavery which Year 8 pupils are learning about in History.

Transport will be provided by the school to and from the museum. It is anticipated that we will be leaving school at 8.30am on Thursday morning and returning to school at approximately 3pm (dependent on traffic). Pupils will need to wear school uniform for the visit. They will also need to bring a pen and notepad with them. Your child may bring their mobile phone but mobile phone use will not be permitted during the event. We will not have access to any medication that they normally leave in school. As the catering facilities are limited for large school groups, you will need to provide your child with a packed lunch on the day. Any pupil who has a free school meal, will be provided with a packed lunch.

If you would like your child to attend the trip, please complete the attached permission slip by Monday 6th February. **Once all reply slips are in we will allocate 50 places on a lottery basis** and payment of £16 will then be required on the school gateway by Monday 27th February. Payment must be made online via the school gateway.
